## IMPORTANT INSTALLER CHECKLIST

### Checklist of things you need to know before your installer leaves:-

Dear Installer / Customer,

The checklist below is an aid to help obtain the optimum installation and identifies the key points and features of the fire being installed.

**We recommend that you go through the list with your customer so that you can help with any questions the customer may have before completion of installation.**

All the points below are covered in detail in the comprehensive Installer & Owner Guide supplied with the appliance which we encourage you to read. However, this checklist summarises the key areas of operation / installation to ensure optimum set up of fire.

No.	Checklist Points	✓
1	Demonstrate how the appliance works and ensure you have operated the appliance at least twice to ensure the customer has operated appliance and is comfortable with the lighting and turning off procedures. Customer should perform this procedure.	
2	Light fire and leave running for 10-15 minutes in order to demonstrate the flame picture is performing at optimum level.	
3	Does the appliance use batteries? If yes, please demonstrate to customer how to replace battery(s) and where they are located.	
4	Does the appliance have loose coals/pebbles/logs? If yes, please explain the importance of having the coal/pebbles/logs correctly positioned.	
5	If you are connecting to existing pipe work, have you checked pipe work is free of any contaminates such as copper sulphide? <b>NOTE:</b> Prior to connecting the gas supply it is advisable to blow out the gas supply so that any dirt which may be present in the pipe is cleared and cannot enter the gas valve or pilot burner and so cause a blockage.	
6	For fitting to a conventional chimney which has a strong flue pull, consider fitting / adjusting the spigot restrictor to optimise the efficiency and flame picture.	

Note:

- The above points should be read in conjunction with your Installer & Owner Guide and Ceramic Guide. This Checklist does not replace them.
- This checklist should be retained by customer with the Installer & Owner Guide and Ceramic Guide.
